Hello Ms. Mathes,

The City of Apalachicola has been found to be in Non-Compliance with the TRIM statutes 200.065, F.S. To bring the city into compliance, you will need to re-advertise and re-hold your final TRIM hearing. The advertisement has to have a violation clause and must be accompanied by a Budget Summary ad.

I've attached examples of the budget hearing advertisement with the violation clause. I've also placed the links to the web page so you can download a new DR-487 and DR-487V.


